RULES

1. All entries subject to fair approval.
2. Only one (1) vehicle per person or organization.
3. Only one (1) Farm implement piece allowed in parade per dealer.
4. Antique Cars must be at least 25 years old.
5. Only one (1) float/entry per political party. Only parties listed on the 2019 November ballot allowed.
6. Individual political candidates will not be allowed entry to the parade. Please plan to walk with political party entry or float.
7. Parade steps off promptly at 1:00pm. Please be in place by noon. Float judging is at 11am.
8. NO motorbikes, unicycles, or bicycles of any type will be admitted.
9. Derby Cars must be registered and approved for the parade through Shalene Williams (734) 847-6726.
10. Participants may not perform while marching.
11. **ABSOLUTELY NO THROW-OUTS OR GIVE-AWAYS ARE TO BE HANDED OUT FROM THE PARADE LINE.**
Persons violating this rule will be asked to leave the parade.
12. Operate vehicles safely and cautiously and keep sirens and honking horns to a minimum.

JUDGED FLOAT CONTEST:

Division I will be open to floats entered in the parade by businesses and corporations.

Cash prizes of \$50.00, \$40.00, \$30.00, \$25.00, \$20.00, and \$10.00 will be awarded.

Division II will be open to floats entered in the parade by non-profit organizations only.

Cash prizes of \$50.00, \$40.00, \$30.00, \$25.00, \$20.00, and \$10.00 will be awarded.

Division III will be open to floats entered in the parade by 4-H only.

Cash prizes of \$250.00, \$200.00, \$150.00, \$100.00, and \$100.00 will be awarded.

Entries must be received by July 12, 2019 to be eligible for prizes. You must have a float number assigned by the Fair to be judged. Please pick up your float number at the Fair office between July 22-26. Judging begins at 11am on Sunday, July 29. Please be in place a few minutes early. Confirmation and parade details will be mailed to all registered entries after July 21. Floats will be judged according to criteria, including adherence to fair theme.
