

2020 Monroe County Fair Kids' Power Wheels Demolition Derby Entry Blank Tuesday, August 4, 2020

PREPARATION

Checklist for parents and prospective participants for the 5th Annual Monroe County Fair Kids' Power Wheels Demo Derby Tuesday, August 4, 2020 (run during the 6p.m. show at approximately 7p.m.).

- 1. File a paid \$10 Entry (form attached) on or before July 31. Entries after deadline \$15 and may be limited.
- 2. File a fully executed Minor Release and Waiver of Liability form (see contact information attached) on or before July 31.
- 3. Drop off Power Wheels vehicle between 3p.m. and 6p.m. on August 4 at the Derby Pit Gate (no pit access for kids).
- 4. Purchase a Fair Admission ticket and a Demolition Derby Grandstand Admission ticket and enjoy the 6p.m. Show from the grandstands.
- 5. Listen for the Derby PA Announcer's call for parents and participants to report trackside.
- 6. Enjoy participating in the Kids' Power Wheels Demo Derby.
- 7. Receive an award after the race on the track (all kids).
- 8. Retrieve Power Wheels vehicle before 9p.m. at the Derby Pit Gate.

POWER WHEELS DEMOLITION DERBY RULES

- 1. Any regular electric standard size Power Wheel is allowed with the following restrictions: no "wedge" body styles, no ATV, quad, motorcycle etc. type vehicles allowed; child's legs must be in a compartment; any vehicle deemed to be unsafe for any reason will not be allowed to compete; decisions of officials are final. No modifications unless expressly stated in these rules.
- 2. Kids 3-10 years of age may participate. There are two age groups: 3-5 and 6-10.
- 3. Helmets must be worn (bicycle helmet, etc.).
- 4. The vehicle is allowed to have UPTO a 12 volt lawn mower battery, which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat and battery must be secured and sealed away from the child. Motor must remain stock. The ONLY modification allowed is using a lawn mower battery. Power Wheel may be weighed for compliance.
- 5. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking. Cosmetic changes are acceptable, however, no reinforcement will be allowed to the Power Wheels (body, frame, etc., must remain original).
- 6. All children will receive a participation prize.
