Scout participants must:

- Be a member in good standing of BSA and have their Scoutmaster's/Advisor's recommendation to participate
- Have a minimum one year experience in Scouting, Scouts BSA or the Venturing Programs
- Be present at the start of the event (no mid-week arrivals, please) and live on site all week

Adult participants must:

- Be a registered leader, at least 21 years of age by the start of the event, with Boy Scouts of America
- Have current Youth Protections Certification and have completed other applicable BSA trainings
- Either live and work onsite all week or come out and help on a daily basis
