Application packets, available on our webpage in mid March, are due June 15, 2024.

Scout participants must:

- •Be a member in good standing of BSA and have a Scoutmaster's/Advisor's recommendation to participate.
- Register with Crew 1948 at no charge.
- Have a minimum of one year of experience in the Scouts, BSA or Venturing Programs, including at least one long term camping experience. (This requirement may be waived if the applicant has equivalent experience and their Unit Leader's recommendation.)
- •Be present at the start of the event (no midweek arrivals allowed) and live on site all week.

Adult participants must:

- •Be a registered leader with Boy Scouts of America and be at least 21 years of age by the start of the event.
- Have current Youth Protection Certification and have completed other applicable BSA training.
- •Register with Crew 1948 at no charge.
- •Live and work onsite all week or come out to help on a daily basis.
