



STREET OEM STOCK DEMOLITION DERBY RULES 2026

If it doesn't say you can, then you can't. Any vehicle that is built any more than what is listed below will not run in this class.

Any 1980 and newer 2-wheel drive passenger car or minivan. No trucks, convertibles, jeeps, full size vans, travelalls, suburbans, hearse, utility vehicles or V-8 engine vehicles allowed.

Vehicle must be stripped of all glass, headlights, taillights and anything else that could fall off onto the track during the show. All Airbags must be removed.

Vehicles must remain stock to original OEM build. Do not alter the bumper in any way. Factory bumper shocks must remain in the factory location if used. No welding on bumpers. You may double strand 9 wire the bumpers in 2 locations per bumper.

NO WELDING anywhere besides the driver's door. Driver's door welds limited to maximum 6 inches per vertical seam. All other doors must be wired, chained or seat belted in 4 places per seam.

Batteries may be left in stock location or moved to passenger floor or seat area. Battery must be covered and completely secured in place. If the battery is located behind the axle it must be moved to the rear seat area.

Factory gas tank may remain in place if it is in front of an axle. Factory or aftermarket tanks may be used but must be completely secured in place.

Hoods and Trunks may be wired or chained in 4 places total. Sheet metal to sheet metal only. Nothing to frame. If you remove trunk wire or chain 2 places total.

For driver safety, rear seat bars may be added and welded post to post. Simple cage 2x2 may be installed but no legs to sheet metal. Driver door only may have plate welded to outside (maximum 12" wide, no more than 8" beyond driver door) or door filled with concrete for driver safety. Approved seat belts, helmet, long sleeve shirt, long pants, full coverage shoes required.

DOT tires only. Stock wheels with no metal added to them. All wheel weights must be removed. Only tubes and air are permitted inside of tires.

All cars should be presentable. No offensive language, symbols or images allowed (swastikas, Confederate Flags, profanity, etc.). Numbers must be on both doors and roof, minimum size 16" high, 2" wide, contrasting color to rest of car paint.

If it does not say you can do it then that means YOU CANNOT do it.

CAR ENTRY AND PIT ENTRY INFORMATION

PIT PASSES: Driver pit passes are no charge (with paid entry fee), pit passes for crew members and others associated with the race team are \$25. All pit passes do include admission to the Fair. **The pit area is an insurance restricted non-spectator area**, anyone entering the pit area must be affiliated with a Derby car, under age 18 must have fully executed minor release with parental signature, and no pit passes will be sold to small children (no strollers, no toddlers, no babe-in-arms).

- CAR ENTRY FEE: \$25 if received by Friday, July 31 by mail or at Fairgrounds office. Late entries of \$50 will be accepted after deadline at pit gate until start of Derby. Must register for heat race at time of pit pass sign-in on Derby Day. NO REFUNDS for any reason (fail inspection, mechanical failure, unable to start at time of race, etc). Car & driver must run in assigned heat race as registered unless permission secured at Scoring Stand. **All cars must be registered/inspected by 7pm.**

DERBY RACE RULES

To be covered in detail at Driver's Meetings: Driver's door/head-on hits not allowed and may result in disqualification; Cars must hit/make contact with other running cars every 30 seconds or may be disqualified; Driver safety equipment will be rechecked as car enters track for race; Drivers qualified for feature may not run another heat in that class; Feature cars must have run in heat race. Heat races will have a time limit, if more than 3 cars remain when time expires no cars from that heat will transfer to the feature and they will move into the Last Chance race.

GENERAL

No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances allowed in pit, staging, track or grandstand area. All participants agree that decisions of the race officials (inspection, race procedure, scoring etc.) are final, and there shall be no protests. In keeping with the family theme of the Monroe County Fair, anything considered detrimental or negatively impacting the Fair will subject participants to disqualification/removal from grounds.
